Dear MPI Candidate/Prospective Student;


Members of the Massachusetts Board of Registration in Nursing (Board) at their meeting on November 18, 2015 reviewed the status of the Medical Professional Institute, Practical Nursing Program (Program) in light of the Program's ongoing annual NCLEX less than 80% for first time writers pass rate (2014-77%, 2013-70% and 2012- 68%). The Board voted to find the Practical Nursing Program has not provided satisfactory evidence of its compliance with the following regulations: 244 CMR 6.04(1)(b), (1)(c), (1)(e), (1)(g), (2)(b)(5), (3)(a)2, (4)(a), (4)(b)3, (4)(b)4, (4)(b)5, (5)(a), (5)(c) and (5)(f) and as a result the Board determined that the Program warrants "Approval with Warning" status.

Please be aware that all current students graduating from the Practical Nursing Program at MPI are eligible to write the NCLEX-PN. Additionally, all graduates from the Practical Nursing Program at MPI who have not yet written the NCLEX-PN remain eligible to do so.

Also please note that Medical Professional Institute welcomes suggestions by the Board for improvement of its PN Program and has immediately started to take all corrective actions to ensure a satisfactory response to the Board's action by Spring of 2016.
